
## Italian Open & Capri Exclusive Tour

The exclusive tour starts with the semi-final and final matches of Italy's premier Masters 1000 event, the Italian Open. You will enjoy the matches from premier seats at the Foro Italico. Between our time at the tennis tournament we will enjoy private, guided tours of some of Rome's most fascinating places. We will stay in a boutique hotel, located in a in central Rome. After experiencing the thrill of the tournament and the sites of Rome, we will head to the magical island of Capri.





We will spend four nights in a boutique hotel on the island of Capri. While on the island, there will be time for you to explore on your own, as well as enjoy a private boat excursion around the island, and privately-guided visits to some of the island's highlights. You will have the chance to test your tennis skills on clay by



participating in tennis clinics led by our tennis pro on the island. All while enjoying the jaw-dropping beautiful scenery of the island.

We will head back to the mainland for our last night in Naples, on the way, we will explore Pompeii with a private archeologist to guide us through the ruins and bring the village back to life through stories and descriptions. After the tour, we will head to a boutique hotel on the promenade of Naples for one night.

May 14: Afternoon walking tour of Rome – to catch a glimpse of and learn a little about some of the city's highlights. We will end the walking tour at an acclaimed ristorante near the hotel. (dinner)

**May 15:** Optional early morning tours of Rome highlights with a local guide to visit the sites with a unique insider's perspective. In the afternoon we will head to Foro Italico, to experience the quarterfinals of the BNL Internazionali di Roma, Italian style (breakfast, lunch)

*May 16*: Today's highlight will be the semi-finals of the BNL Internazionali di Roma in premier seats at Foro Italico. After tennis, we will enjoy dinner in Rome.(breakfast, dinner)

**May 17**: We will depart Rome with our private transportation to the gulf of Naples where we will embark a ferry to the island of Capri (breakfast, lunch).

May 18: Capri is both posh and dramatic...it offers something for everyone! You may join the tennis clinic on the courts near the hotel, or just enjoy the hotel amenities. In the afternoon we will visit some unique places the island has to offer and enjoy the views and nature that Capri has to offer. (breakfast, dinner)

May 19: Enjoy a morning tennis clinic or just relax. In the afternoon we will enjoy a private boat tour of the island.

May 20: Capri is yours to enjoy! Head to a beach club, take a hike, relax at the pool, shop, more tennis... (breakfast)

May 21: We will depart Capri in the morning to head back to the mainland, have lunch and visit Pompeii with a private guide. Afterwards we will drive to Naples. (breakfast, lunch, dinner)

May 22: Everyone will go on their way after breakfast! Arrivederci! (breakfast)
